

Service/Work Groups at Camp on the Boulder

Thank you for choosing Camp on the Boulder for your gift of service! You will be a blessing to our Camp, and we pray that you will also be blessed while you are our guests. You will be helping us as we strive to fulfill our mission...*celebrate God's creation while providing an atmosphere, for all to know Jesus Christ.*

Here are a few expectations the Camp has regarding Service/Work groups...

- Group members & leaders have a desire to serve the Lord at Camp on the Boulder, and honor the Camp's mission statement.
- Group members & leaders agree to abide by all Camp policies for guests and staff, especially regarding safety issues.
- Group members & leaders have energy to work and are enthusiastic about the projects.
- Group members & leaders have signed a volunteer participation and release agreement, and also have a health form on file with their leaders.
- Group members will serve from 1 to 6 hours a day, with time for recreation as decided by their leaders.
- If the group has youth, the group will have a ratio of adults to youth of 1:6.
- Group members will take time to enjoy God's creation in the mountains. They may participate in other activities at Camp on the Boulder, such as campfire sing-a-longs, camp store, craft cabin, Frisbee golf, sand volleyball, basketball, horseshoes, hiking, fishing (bring your gear), etc.
- Group members will make a gift to the Camp to cover expenses as suggested below.

Service/Work Group Costs...

- Most mission groups realize that we can't offer big discounts in exchange for volunteer work, since the work must be supervised, and there are still all the costs of operating our ministry. But we try to offer a small discount as a "thank you."
- Service/Work groups will receive an amount off per person per hour worked, up to 50% of the daily cost.
- If you work more than 6 hours, we are delighted, but we can only discount your stay up to 50%.
- **Groups are also invited to bring a gift to cover the expenses of the project, if they are able. Proxy volunteers may send money with you, instead of coming themselves.**

Yes, we want to come, now what?

- Call the Camp and make a reservation for your group with the manager. You will get to sign a contract and make a deposit, just like our regular guests.
- Keep in touch with the manager, regarding your group's schedule and wants. You are coming to serve us, but we are here to serve you, too!
- Pray! Pray for the Camp. Pray for your group. Pray for safety. Pray for God's blessings. Have your home church sponsor individuals through prayer.

What to bring?

- Tools for the project. Work gloves. Sturdy shoes. Old clothes.
- Name tags (so we may call you by name ☺)
- Sleeping bag, pillow, towel, toiletry items, etc.
- Extra clothes, clothes for all kinds of weather.
- Money for camp store treats and souvenirs.
- Bible.
- Flashlight and Camera.
- Swimsuit or shorts for wading in river.
- **Calling card (cell phones don't work here)**
- A servant's heart.
